Indonesian Medical Council (InaMC)


- A national independent and non-structural body established in 2005 under the Indonesia Medical Act No 29/2004
- Consists of Medical Council and Dental Council
- Directly responsible to President of RI


Roles of InaMC

- To register medical doctors and dentists
- To approve standards of medical and dental education
- To guard good medical practice






Membership of InaMC (KKI)

ROADMAP MEDICAL PRACTICE




Registration of Practitioners

- Every doctor or dentist including specialist must be registered by KKI before practicing professional job
- Registration is valid for 5 years

- Requirements for registration :
 - Graduates from university (doctors/ dentists/ specialists)
 - Certificate of competence issued by Indonesian colleges of physicians
 - Health certificate
- Recertification is based on CPD or CME which is organized by professiobnal organizations



Higher Education System in Indonesia


- Regulation: the National Higher Education




Higher Education System in Indonesia


(National Education System Act UU No 20/2003)



Trilogy of Medical Education (WFME,2003)







Career Path of Medical Profession










Basic Medical Education

 - Admission Exams (National/ University)
- Length of study :
 - 6 years
- University:
 - Medicine: 72 Schools (31 Public, 41 Private)
 - Dental : 26 Schools (14 Public, 12 Private)

- University-Hospital based education/training
- Specialties :




- Organized by professional organization:

 Accredited as a pre-requisite for recertification by colleges



Standard of Medical Practice




SERIOUS PROFESSIONAL MISCONDUCT

(Decree of KKI No. 17/KKI/KEP/VIII/2006)

- Fail to medical management :
 - incompetence
 - gross negligence
- Unprofessional behavior
- Unfit to practice





Sanctions to discipline

- Written warning
- Suspending registration (temporary –> permanent)
- Re-schooling
